What is the format of this video study?

Do I need the study guide to do the study?

How do I access the videos?

If you signed up for the study, log in with your email and password to <https://my.stpaulcenter.com/library> and select the thumbnail “A Guided Journey: The Bible and the Church Fathers”.

You will also receive a weekly email reminder every Tuesday (September 20 to October 25) with the link to the videos and a brief description of each lesson.

Are the videos downloadable?

No, the videos are not downloadable.


How do I ask Mike questions?

Participants of the study will receive a special email each week with a link to submit your questions for Mike. He will do his best to answer the submissions. Q & A videos will go up a week after the corresponding sessions. The question videos will appear on the video player queue titled, “Week 1 – Q&A with Mike,” etc...

What if I miss a week?

The videos will remain on your video player queue until you watch them. The oldest videos will be on the top and will “gray out” once you watch it. If you did not complete a video, the video player will remember where you left off when you log back in.

Can I re-watch a lesson once I complete it?

Yes, videos can be re-watched by clicking on the lesson’s refresh symbol 

How long will I have access to the videos?
